The Tube, founded in Lecce in 2023, is the new project by architect Giulio Mariano of Studio Light Mariano and Dominique Wolniewicz.

With roots dating back to 1898, Mariano Light has created an international portfolio in the field of event lighting, working on historic buildings, interiors, shopping malls, weddings, live events, fashion shows and installations for festivals and public spaces. Over the years, the company has collaborated with prestigious international brands such as Tiffany, Bulgari and Dolce & Gabbana, carrying out projects in 22 different countries.

The showroom, located in a 28 meters a long gallery, offers a one-of-a-kind immersive experience to visitors. The name "The Tube" evokes a feeling of continuity and fluidity, reflecting the goal behind creating a modern and innovative lighting experience.

Some of the most renowned architects, designers and artists, who have worked in the Salento and Apulian areas in the past, were involved in the concept phase for The Tube's launch collection to create unique illuminations.

Each work expresses the artistic vision and creativity of its authors, who have interpreted the distinctive elements of our territory in an original way.

The artist, Ginger, begins with a quote from the film Snow White, "Mirror, mirror on the wall... who is the fairest of them all?" This quote serves as the starting point for exploring the concept of immortalizing and projecting our image into the future, a notion that remains relevant today. In homage to the skilled craftsmen of Apulia, the artist employs lights to construct a luminous tunnel, akin to a time-traveling black hole that moves at the speed of light.




